Objectives of the Policy

- 1. To protect and conserve ecological systems and resources within the campus.
- 2. To ensure efficient use of environmental sources and create environmental sustainability.
- To make the campus plastic free by banning plastic and promoting 3 Rs (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle).
- 4. To ensure reduction in our carbon footprints.
- To encourage activities like vermicomposting, rain water harvesting both on campus and off campus.
- 6. To conduct Environmental and Energy audit.

Landscaping Initiatives with trees and plants

Our college campus is not only a place to study but a place for sports, relaxation and aesthetic appreciation for which sustainable infra-structure is a must. Green campus and landscape not only help to recharge ground water but also ensures clean and cool air. Green cover of college is home for a huge number of flora and fauna species.

Clean Campus Initiatives

In accordance to Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, College has committed to actively coordinate cleanliness activities in the college and beyond the campus. Full time adequate supporting staff supervised by associated Committee are appointed for the maintenance of litter free clean and Green Campus. These initiatives include:

- Generating mass awareness on cleanliness and hygiene amongst students and staff members by holding regular cleanliness drives.
- Activities under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' is a key component of all the community works being done by NSS, NCC, Rovers and Rangers.
- Commitment to manage and segregate waste and maintain clean campus.





Clean Air Initiatives

College encourages staff for carpooling to control air pollution. Smoking and burning of garbage are strictly prohibited in campus. The abundant natural landscape cleans the air in campus. An anti-tobacco campaign is a social as well as environmental drive conducted on the campus. A strict adherence to restricted entry of automobiles within the campus.

Waste Management Processes

- 1. Liquid waste management
 - o Maintain leak proof water fixtures.
 - Continued employment of a caretaker to take immediate steps to stop any water leakage through taps, pipes, tanks, and toilet flush etc.

2. Solid waste management

The college will adopt practices to mitigate the generation and manage solid waste through the following methods:

- Systematically engage with the 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) for eco-friendly practices.
- o Collect paper waste in campus and sent for recycling.
- o Take initiatives to spread awareness among students about:
 - Food wastage and ways of minimizing it under Go Brown Initiative.
 - Minimizing the use of packaged food.
 - Use of degradable waste for composting purpose.





3. E-waste management

College ensures that its usage of technology and generation of e-waste does not impact the environment. For this purpose, the college plans to strive towards:

 Awareness amongst students about reduction of e-waste and making provisions for environment friendly disposal.

Environment Centric Awareness Activities

College encourages awareness programs, plantation program, Cleanliness drive in and beyond the campus, Celebration of Various Environmental days.

Green Audit

The college aims to conduct a Green Audit to assess strengths and weaknesses for long- term sustainability. Energy Audit
